The Worry Chart.

A businessman once made a "Worthy Chart", on which he recorded all his troubles and woes. After a year of this worrisome task, he decided to tabulate the results.

He found that 40% of his anxieties turned out to be things that were unlikely to happen.

Thirty per cent were about decisions he had made - and could not unmake.

Twelve per cent of his worries were based on people's criticism of him,

Just sit quietly and soak up His goodness.

Worry is like a rocking chair - it gives you something to do but gets you nowhere.
