Myles Kavanagh local historian: will give a talk on The Royal Oak Village in Muinebheag Library next Tuesday 21st Aug at 8pm. All are welcome. Origin of the name "Royal Oak" can be traced back to an oak tree in a park of many oaks where the monarch of a Kingdom sought refuge from the forces of a once loyal subject. Charles 11 was the monarch (Reign as King of England, Scotland and Ireland – 1660 -1685); Oliver Cromwell was the Monarch's loyal subject. Many places and taverns have since adopted the name "Royal Oak" in commemoration of this event and one of these was the Royal Oak Inn in the townland of Clorusk Lower, on the bank of the river Barrow in Co. Carlow and from here grew the village of the Royal Oak. The Royal Oak Road connects the village to Bagenalstown in which Regent Street was the first street of the town. Folklore of the area also connects King James 11 on his venture in Ireland and flight from the Battle of the Boyne in 1690. Myles Kavanagh explores the history and development of "The Royal Oak Village" in the County of Carlow in his lecture which takes place in Muinebheag Library.
