This is what we believe happens in baptism and so the beginning of our Lenten journey is inextricably linked to our baptismal

# journey.

The sign of the cross is made as the ashes are put on our foreheads. The priest or the minister says 'Repent, and believe in the Gospel,' or similar words.

The signing with ashes reminds us of our dying to the old way of life in baptism and challenges us to live our lives in the light of faith.

"Thus should one regard us, as servants of Christ". Are you being called to serve the Lord and others in the priesthood?
