Bishop Denis will celebrate Mass: in Carlow Cathedral this Sunday the 28th October at 12.30pm to mark the 5th Anniversary of the Ordination to the Diaconate of our seven permanent deacons and the introduction of the permanent diaconate to the Diocese. The Diaconate is an ordained ministry which is rooted in scripture and is open to single and married men. Permanent deacons complement the contribution and work of our priests, religious and lay ministers and are therefore a source of support to us all.
