Bless every fireside, every wall and door.

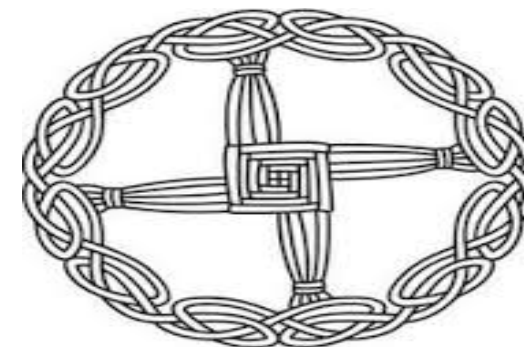

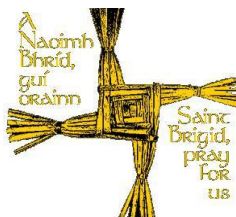
