

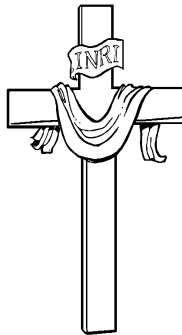

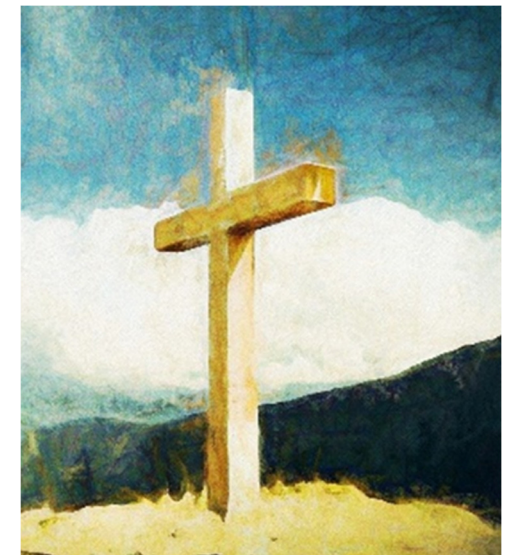
Lenten Scripture Sharing
