A businessman once made a "Worthy Chart", on which he recorded all his troubles and woes.

It's amazing how much worry can be alleviated when we talk to God about our concerns and, in effect, given them over to His care.

And don't add worry about how to pray to your list of concerns.

If you can't find words to express your troubles, God knows your heart and mind and hears you even when you don't speak.

Just sit quietly and soak up His goodness.

Worry is like a rocking chair - it gives you something to do but gets you nowhere.
