We are now in the Month of November when we remember our Deceased Family Members, Relatives, Friends & The Holy Souls.

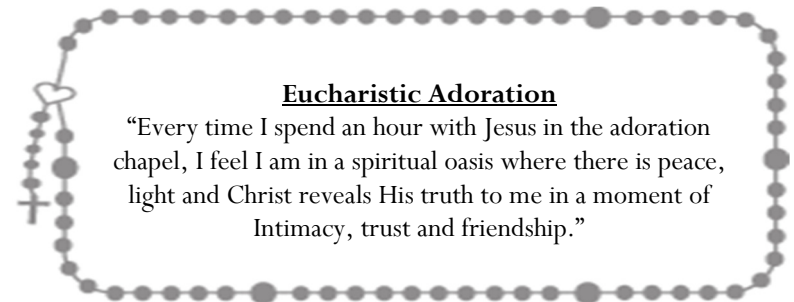
