Leighlinbridge Community Group: Just to make you aware that dog fouling is a major concern in our community, not just because of the mess it causes, but because it can be a public health risk. Dogs may deposit roundworm eggs (toxocara canis) in their faeces, which become infectious after about 3 weeks, and can remain so for up to 2 years. Anyone, but particularly children playing near the ground, can run the risk of picking up and swallowing the eggs. Dog faeces may also contain microorganisms that are both pathogenic to everyone and resistant to several classes of antibiotics. We want to encourage all dog owners to be responsible and clean up after their dogs and dispose of it in a proper way. Also there is a £150 fine on the spot fine enforced by your local County Council.

He was made Bishop by Pope Honorius 1 in 630.

He returned to Ireland & became Bishop of Leighlin.

He was the 1st Bishop of Leighlin.

He held a synod in Leighlin in 634 where he announced the new systems of celebrating Easter which were opposed by Fintan.

He founded a monastery in Old Leighlin of 1500 monks.

He died the 18th April 639 & was buried in Old Leighlin.
