Just a little update on projects in the village. In February of this year a small orchard was planted in St Lazerian's National School. These Irish Heritage apple trees, include eaters, cookers and dual purpose varieties for example Clearheart, Knight's Templar, Mrs Perry, Belvedere House, Lough Key Crab, Kerry Pippin, Red Brandy, Ballyvaughan seedling, Strippy and Brady. As you are aware orchards attract key pollinators, helping to provide a good crop of apples. They also attract a wide variety of organisms, including predator species who prevent damage to the crop by managing pests. Thus, eliminating the use of chemicals.
