Allow hedges to grow into a natural A-shape profile rather than a neat box shape. <u>Why</u>: Native hedgerow plants such as Hawthorn (also called Whitethorn), and Blackthorn flower early in Spring, providing vital food for wild bees when they emerge from hibernation.
